## 1. Delivery

Each course will be delivered in the appropriate manner suitable to individual requirements. Contact us for more information.

## 2. Participant eligibility

- To be eligible to enrol in training purchased under the PPP, participants must not be enrolled in secondary or other tertiary education and training and be either Australian citizens, permanent Australian residents or Humanitarian Refugees. Participants are required to sign a declaration to this effect.
- Participants must be NSW residents and/or work in NSW.
- Participants may have previously undertaken or completed other training programs, as long as they are not currently involved in those programs and continue to meet all other participant eligibility requirements.

An **Existing Worker** means someone who is a NSW resident and works in NSW and is:

- a person 20 years of age or older who has been in paid employment for more than one hour in the week prior to commencement of training, or
- a person 15-19 years of age who is not formally enrolled in school and has been in paid employment for more than 15 hours in the week prior to commencement of training.

A **Job Seeker** means someone who is a NSW resident and is:

- registered with an Job Services Australia provider, or
- an income support recipient who is not currently required to meet activity test or participation requirements, or
- a participant in the Community Development Employment Projects scheme, or
- not currently working and seeking or intending to seek paid employment or self-employment after completing training - this definition includes people 15-19 years of age who are not formally enrolled in school and in paid employment for 15 hours or less in the week prior to commencement of training, or people 20 years of age or older who have been in paid employment for one hour or less in the week prior to commencement of training, or
- a participant in the Commonwealth's Access Program, or not working and participating in volunteering activities.

## 3. Exemption from payment of fees

Fee exemption

- Participants undertaking training may be eligible for exemption from payment of the fee if they fall into the eligibility categories currently applied by TAFE NSW. Eligible participants can claim an exemption from the fee only once per year.
- Where a participant has been granted an exemption from payment of the fee, the RTO must keep an auditable copy of proof of the exemption.
